

Beth McMillan is a second-year DPhil student in the department of Computer Science, studying drug side-effects.

She began studying singing in West Sussex under the excellent tutelage of the (now sadly deceased) Janet McCleery, and took up the flute at the age of eight when her parents finally gave in to her insistent begging. While at secondary school Beth sang with the West Sussex County Youth Choir and in various chamber choirs around the region, taking on soprano, alto and (in desperate times) tenor parts.
